 - Herd bull
- Pasture grazed 365 days per year
- Low stress nose ring weaning
- Stockpiled forage - no crop residue grazing
- Supplemental hay fed on pasture
- Eastern gamagrass planting
- Warm season CRP grass grazing July-September
- Mineral program & organic fly control
- Solar powered fence and water
- Tire tank year round frost proof water
- Poly wire temporary paddocks
- Automatic time controlled Batt-Latch gate release
- Native grass, forb, flower identification
- Pollinator, bird, wildlife observations
- Monitoring forages and soil carbon
